Impact Assessment of Intel Operations with the 2008 Beijing Olympics

- China announced plans to improve air quality during the 2008 Olympics by shutting down certain industrial operations within 200 km of Beijing between July 17 and September 20, 2008.
- Intel assessed the disruption potential for key operations, suppliers, and shipping capabilities due to the proposed industrial shutdowns.
- All currently identified impacts are minor and indirect. They are being addressed.
- At this time Intel expects no disruption to normal operations or shipments.
- Intel has a robust business continuity effort as part of its readiness, response, and recovery capability; routinely planning for a wide array of potential impacts and assuring effective response and recovery systems, processes, and capabilities.
